

Associate Professor Position at Hokkaido University, Japan

The Department of Behavioral Science at Hokkaido University invites applications for an associate professor position in the fields of social psychology and related disciplines, beginning Spring 2012. Responsibilities include teaching and supervising undergraduate, master's, and/or Ph.D. courses and theses, in addition to research and service.

Qualifications: The successful candidate should have a PhD or equivalent doctorate degree in social psychology or in a related discipline. The candidate must have an established research program that deals with the interaction between social environment and human behavior and psychological processes. The expected starting date is April 2012, but this is open to negotiation.

- 2) Reprints or preprints of five representative publications
- 3) Overview of your previous academic activities (maximum 1500 words)
- 4) Personal statement about your academic activities and education in general (1500-3000 words).
